

A Grand Departure From the Usual

The Manhattan Piano Trio is an ensemble that embodies, in the deepest sense, the borough that provides its namesake.

Hailed by critics as "a grand departure from the usual" (*News Herald*), the Manhattan Piano Trio (MPT) is one of the most creative, exciting, and dynamic young ensembles in America. Now in its 15th season, the ensemble has performed hundreds of concerts for enthusiastic audiences in almost 40 states. Of the trio, the *Sarasota (Fla.) Herald Tribune* stated that "one seldom is privileged to enjoy music of such a wide range of styles performed with self-effacing skill and relaxed assurance."

Shortly after its formation in 2004, MPT captured grand prizes at the Plowman and Yellow Springs Competitions and received the Australian Broadcasting Corporation Listeners' Choice Award at the Melbourne International Chamber Music Competition.

Past seasons have brought the trio to virtually every part of the country. Additionally, they have toured South Africa and Italy. As part of the community rebuilding effort in New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina,




they were one of the first musical groups to perform in the city following the devastation.

Audiences and critics worldwide have praised the talented singers of the Vienna Boys Choir for their celestial voices, rapturous harmonies, pure tone, irresistible charm, and above all, a wide-ranging repertoire spanning centuries.

With a rich history dating back more than 500 years, the Vienna Boys Choir has been associated with many of

the world's great composers, including Mozart, Bruckner and Schubert.

Today, there are 100 choristers from 31 nations between the ages of ten and fourteen, divided into four touring choirs. Between them, they give around 300

performances each year in front of almost half a million people in virtually all European countries and in Asia, Australia, and the Americas.

Since their first audio recording in 1907, the Vienna Boys Choir has re-



corded over 300 singles, LPs, and CDs, the most recent of which is *Strauss For Ever*, their second

recording for Deutsche Grammophon. Their first album on the label, *Merry Christmas from Vienna*, was released in 2016 and continues to be hugely popular.

This season, the group debuts a program titled *Journey*

Through the Americas. This program features a variety of pop, classical, and folk music selections from countries throughout North and South America, and as always, a sprinkling of much-beloved Austrian favorites.

First performed in Dublin, Ireland, in 1742, George Frideric Handel's beloved oratorio *Messiah* is without question the quintessential, don't-miss holiday event for millions of people around the world.

The Sackets Harbor Vocal Arts Ensemble and Orchestra, under the direction of Kyle Ramey, returns this season to perform all three sections of this celebrated ora-

torio. In Part I, the Messiah's coming and the virgin birth are predicted and the annunciation to the shepherds of the birth of Christ occurs. Part II covers Christ's passion and death, his resurrection and ascension, and the first spreading of the gospel throughout the world. Part III begins with the promise of redemption, followed by a prediction of the day of judgment and resurrection of the dead, and ends with the final victory over sin and death and the acclamation of Christ.

This performance marks the 100th concert on the Trinity Concert Series since its founding in 2006. A festive holiday hors d'oeuvres reception will follow this performance to mark the occasion.


Brahms to Beatles

A singularly unique ensemble, the Rastrelli Cello Quartet has been thrilling audiences with their renderings of non-traditional programming since 2002. Kira Kraftzoff (founder and artistic director), Kirill Timofeev, Misha Degtjareff and Sergio Drabkin formed the ensemble with a mission to perform music "between the genres." Their widely varied programs comfortably mix works by Bach, Saint-Saëns and Tchaikovsky with that of George Gershwin, Dave

Brubeck and Leroy Anderson. The name of the quartet is taken from the 18th century architect Bartholomew Rastrelli, who designed the Hermitage in St. Petersburg, Russia, the home city of three of the four Quartet members.

The quartet has performed in many of Europe's great concert halls, including the Gasteig in Munich, Berlin Philharmony, Konzerthaus Vienna, Concertgebouw Amsterdam, St. Petersburg's Philharmonic Hall, Bulgaria Hall Sofia, the Liederhalle Stuttgart, Leiszhall Hamburg and Mariinsky Theater St. Petersburg.

The Rastrelli Quartet currently has seven recordings on the Solo Musica, TonArt, Manchester, and Genuin labels. In 2009, the Rastrelli Quartet's CD *Cello*



in Classic was nominated for a Russian Grammy and was given a second prize award.

Bending genres and uplifting spirits, The Moanin' Frogs saxophone sextet is redefining what

chamber music can be. Rooted in the classical tradition and theater of the American Vaudeville show, The Moanin' Frogs' spirited arrangements, creative choreography,

and technically precise performances of jazz, pop, and classical music delight fans across the world.

The first touring group of their instrumentation since the early 1930s, The Moanin' Frogs demonstrate the full line of saxophones. This gives

The Frogs a big, symphonic sound and the ability to perform both highlights from the Vaudeville repertoire and entire orchestral works with only six players. Their name, a contraction of the 1914 and 1916 hit titles, *That Moanin' Saxophone Rag* and *The Bull Frog Blues*, also hints at their ability to hop convincingly between genres: they are at home as concerto soloists and burlesque show musicians, jazz improvisers and primo

chamber ensemble players.

Committed to inspiring future generations of musicians, The Frogs recently entered into partnership with the Conn-Selmer Division of Education, which kicked off at the 2015 Conn-Selmer Institute.

Through this partnership, The Moanin' Frogs give performances and interactive sessions with students nationwide.

Described as a choral ensemble that presents "excellence" and sings "as one...with difficult and breathtaking harmonies," Watertown Musica Viva celebrates ten years of music making in the greater Watertown area. This 4-to 8-part chamber choir first appeared in 2010 singing a program titled "An Olde World Christmas." Subsequent seasons have seen

the ensemble perform many of the greatest a cappella compositions from the 16th to the 21st centuries.

Repertoire highlights have included Randall Thompson's *The Peaceable Kingdom*, Benjamin Britten's *A Ceremony of Carols*, Maurice Duruflé's *Quatre Motets*, Francis Poulenc's *Quatre*

Motets, Aaron Copland's *Four Motets*, C. Hubert H. Parry's *Songs of Farewell*, Richard Bennett's *Five Carols*, and Ralph Vaughan Williams' *Five English Folk Songs*. The group has performed concerts of folk songs, madrigals, motets, music of darkness and light, love songs, and American choral favorites as well

as several concerts in the Christmas and Epiphany seasons.

The choir comprises members from all walks of life who share a love of challenging choral music and dedication to high-quality performance.

Titled *Encore!*, this concert will showcase many of the choir's favorites from the last ten seasons as well as a few new works. From madrigals and motets to music newly composed in the last few years, this concert will have something for all.


