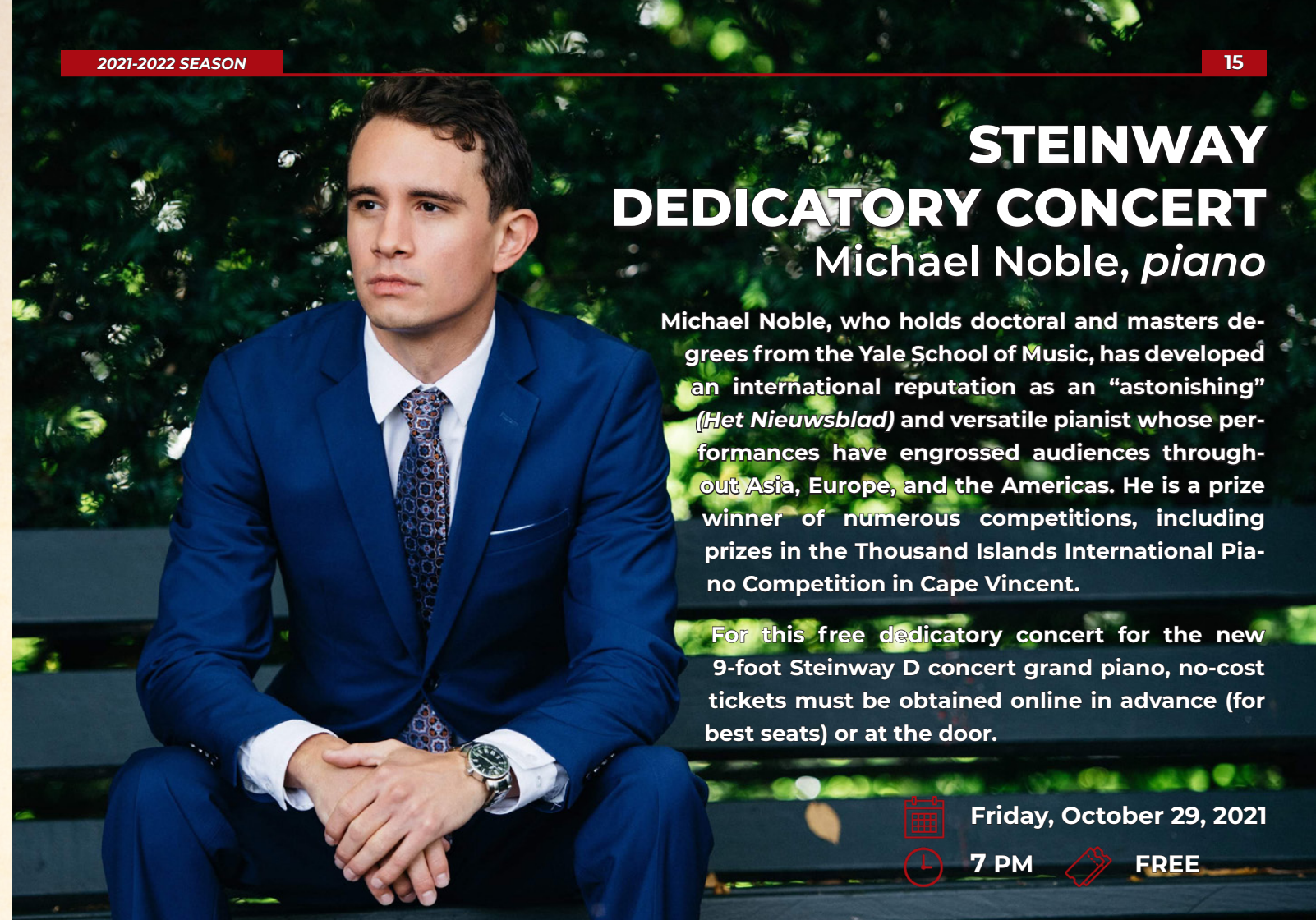

This program will include several selections from Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky's *The Nutcracker Suite, Op. 71a*, as well as many rousing arrangements of well-known Christmas carols and secular Christmas songs.



## Clancy Cox, *soprano* and Noah Landers, *piano*

Lyric soprano Clancy Cox joins award-winning pianist Noah Landers in a Valentine's program that explores both the sunny and stormy sides of love through the Lieder of Romantic Era composer couples Alma & Gustav Mahler and Robert & Clara Schumann. The program will include Mahler's *Lieder eines Fahrenden Gesellen* ("Songs of a Wayfarer") and selected love songs of Strauss and Grieg. Cox and Landers are both very active in the greater-Watertown musical community.





## Brian Preston

Pianist Brian Preston has been proclaimed "a pianist possessing real charm, with musical instincts intelligently put to work" (*Tribune de Genève*) and praised for his "extremely delicately developed feeling for sound nuances" (*Berlin Tagespiegel*). A leader in the Rochester music community, Preston balances private teaching with collegiate piano instruction at Nazareth College. He also serves as the Artistic Director of the Thousand Islands International Piano Competition in Cape Vincent.

## Robert Auler

# WHAT TO EXPECT THIS SEASON

- Most concerts this season have been shortened and will be without intermission for safety.

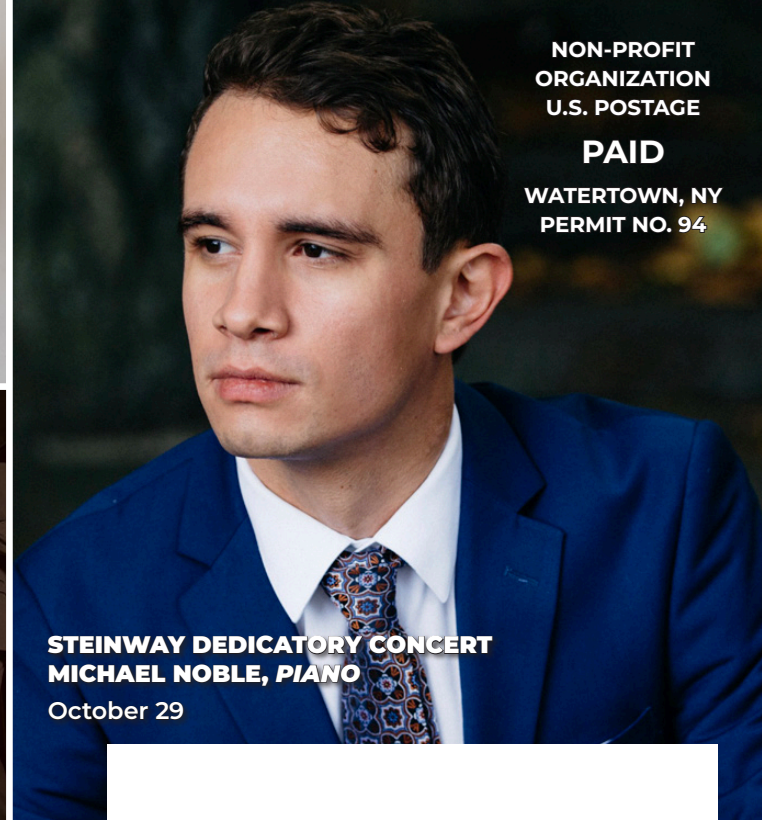
