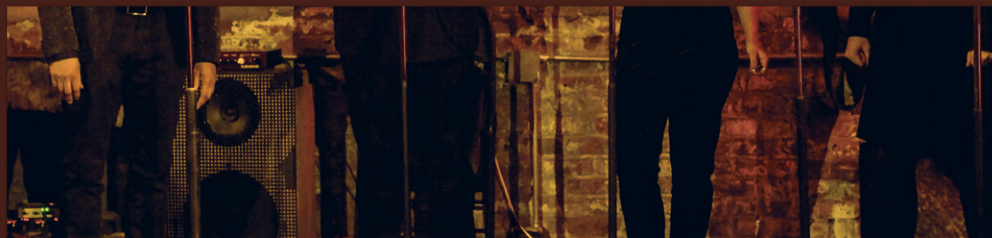

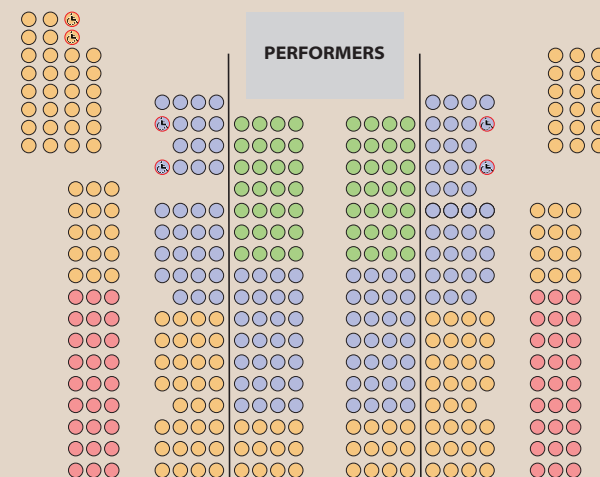

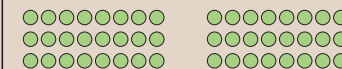

Please note: **All tickets are assigned a specific seat number.** Season Subscription and Flex Pass prices are the same regardless of seating tier (see chart above). For those who order a Flex Pass, instructions on how to redeem your pass will be given at the time of purchase and seat choices can be different for each of the concerts you attend. For season subscriptions, the seat you choose will be yours for the entire season.

Student Tickets Tickets in tiers 3 & 4 are always FREE for all students (K-12 & College). For tier 2 seats, there is a charge of \$2, and for tier 1 seats, there is a charge of \$3. Student tickets are available online, by phone, or in person.

ACCESSIBILITY The Trinity Concert Series welcomes all individuals to our concerts and provides a variety of accommodations.

- Accessible seating is available in various areas throughout the venue. Trinity Church is wheelchair accessible from the city parking lot entrance. Restrooms are all accessible.
- For hearing-impaired patrons, assistive listening devices are available. Please ask an usher for assistance. Please note: *assistive listening devices are only to better understand speaking as we do not amplify the music in the venue.*
- Large-print programs are now available! Please ask an usher for assistance.
- For any guest who requires a paid Caregiver or Personal Care Attendant, we will provide a pass at no cost with a paid admission.
